### **July 1st, David's Skill (games)**

Offering & Prayer

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## Pre/K/Gr.1-6 Curriculum – 2007

### TO THE TEACHER:

#### VHS/DVD days:

1. On VHS/DVD days, the movie will be run in the stage room and in the gym.
2. Before viewing each episode on VHS/DVD day, one teacher will introduce the show and lay out the background scene of the movie.
3. If there is time in the end, there will be question & answer period to emphasize the commandments.

#### Memory:

1. Leader can give a memory verse of their choice.
2. Each class ask students to recount the story as best as they remember
3. Christmas curriculum: is based on the Drama Book Seasonal Pageants- "One Silent Night" (page 49).

#### Fire Flight Curriculum:

1. Each week there is a theme based on a bible story. The bible story stays the same for four weeks, but, the theme or focus of the story is different for each week.  
I.E. Manna in the wilderness is the story; week one tells the story and week two explains why the story happens, week 3 explains what it means to the child and week 4 explains what it means to the church.
2. The deeper learning portion of the curriculum can be repeated over, there are ten choices, and teachers are to choose at least two deeper learning aids for each week. There is one deeper learning aid that fits the theme quite well...try to utilize that aid for the correct theme.
3. Pre-k will try to use the music CD's and have 5 to ten minutes each week learning or doing music.
4. Take-Home pages can be done during class time.

#### Christmas Concert:

1. Christmas curriculum: is based on the Drama Book Seasonal Pageants- "One Silent Night" (page 49).
2. Curriculum may be interrupted to practice the Play during the month of December...

### SPECIAL PROJECTS:

Christmas Party: We will need to come up with gifts for Children that attend regularly and find complementary gifts for the kids that are there on Christmas Sunday.

Mother's Day: Need to arrange some of the children handing out cards or flowers to the mothers.

Father's Day: Drama team Presentation

Rally Sunday: This is the day we congratulate the Children moving up to new classes and welcome them. We need to come up with names or logos for each group. We should appoint a two chair leaders for the group.

All Saints Day or Costume Party: This is to allow the children to show off their Hallowe'en outfits if they celebrate it, but add a twist and allow them to celebrate the Saints of the Bible. We should try to promote the children dressing up as saints or bible Characters.
